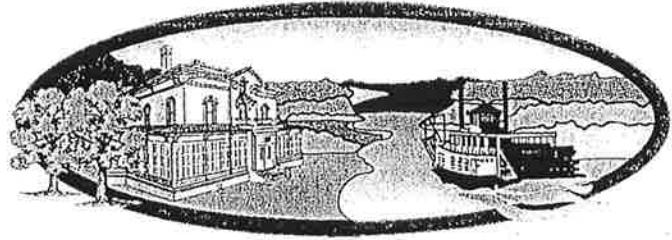

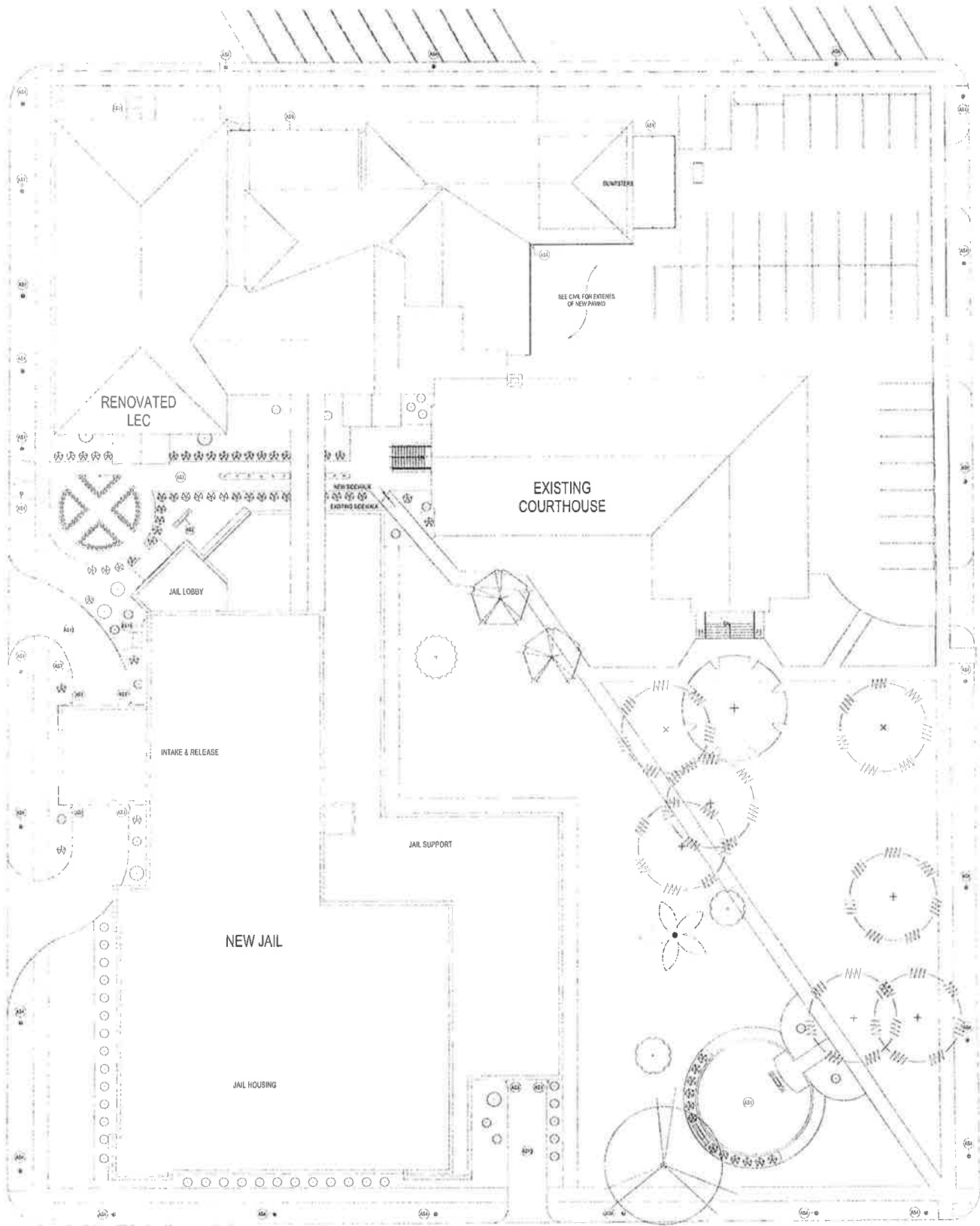

RE: Resolution 2024-02 Adjustment to Urban Boundaries
DATE: March 15, 2024

Before you is a Resolution(2024-02) regarding the Urban Boundaries adjustment that was presented to City staff. Chad and I met with the Wisconsin DOT Urban Planning Department regarding the changes from the previous boundaries. This is a requirement by Federal Law that the State meets with local governments to approve the boundaries after a census every 10 years. This is also important as these Urban Boundaries play a key factor for Federal Surface Transportation Block Grants that we may be eligible for on future projects.

The boundary changes are basically cleaning up a boundary map that had included areas that would not have any population density currently or added into it over the next 10 years. Some of the areas that were reconfigured included realigning the boundary to exclude the Mississippi River and then outlining Hwy 18(over the bridge into Marquette) as the boundary rather than the navigable waterway. This change was recommended by the DOT as roadways are used as the mode of transportation within the urban population for daily commuting.

The Urban area does include portions of the density populated areas of Bridgeport, Township of Prairie du Chien and Marquette, IA(the State of Iowa approved the use which Wisconsin DOT had requested to them). Urban areas use these outlying locations in all urban areas much like Madison would use Verona, Fitchburg, Monona and other municipalities in their Urban Area and as LaCrosse would use Shelby, Onalaska, Town of Campbell(French Island), Holmen and West Salem in their Urban Area data.

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation has submitted an adjusted urban area boundary for the City of Prairie du Chien urban area; and

WHEREAS, the adjustments proposed to the City of Prairie du Chien urban area boundary are summarized in the change table, as shown in Exhibit 1 to this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, after review by the City Officials and staff, the proposed adjusted Urban Area Boundary has been found to be justified.

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation will, after local approval of the proposed boundary, submit the adjusted urban area boundary to the respective FHWA division office;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Prairie du Chien Common Council, Crawford County, Wisconsin that the City of Prairie du Chien informs the Wisconsin Department of Transportation that the Adjusted Urban Area Boundary as outlined in the change table, as shown in Exhibit 1, and reflected in the City of Prairie du Chien map, as shown in Exhibit 2 to this Resolution are approved and adopted on this 19th day of March, 2024

ORDINANCE 2024-03
AN ORDINANCE CREATING SUBSECTION 6 OF CHAPTER 15.04 (SLOW-NO-WAKE) OF
THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF PRAIRIE DU CHIEN, CRAWFORD COUNTY,
WISCONSIN

PURPOSE: THE PURPOSE OF THIS ORDINANCE IS TO CREATE THE ABILITY OF THE CLOSURE OF THE SLOW NO WAKE ZONE.

The Common Council of the City of Prairie du Chien, Crawford County, Wisconsin, does ordain that Chapter 15.04(6) of the Municipal Code be amended to read as follows:

SECTION 1: (6) CLOSURE OF ZONE

1. In the event of an emergency, the mayor or any law enforcement agency, shall have the authority to temporarily close all or any party of the Slow No Wake Zone described in Section (1)(a) for a period of _____ days or less. The City of Prairie du Chien, through the mayor's office or the police department, shall be responsible for informing the public, posting notification at all public access and marking any closure zone with buoys, if necessary.

2. Vessels or boats participating in marine events sanctioned by the City of Prairie du Chien shall be exempt from the provisions of this Section, so long as the vessels or boats are engaged in activities directly related to the City sanctioned event.

3. The Common Council may close all or any part of the Slow No Wake Zone described in Section (1)(a) at any time and for any reason provided notice was provided to the public.

SECTION 2: Any Ordinance or parts thereof, inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall be published as required by law after passage by the Common Council.
