APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY FUNDS FOR THE OPERATION OF THE GOVERNMENT AND ADMINISTRATION OF THE CITY OF PRAIRIE DU CHIEN, CRAWFORD COUNTY, WISCONSIN

Purpose: The purpose of this Ordinance is to establish the overall 2022 tax levy needed to support the City and other taxing jurisdictions.

The Common Council of the City of Prairie du Chien, Crawford County, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of the City of Prairie du Chien for the year 2023, including monies from the general tax levy to the various funds and purposes set up in the budget and presented herewith for the purposes therein set forth, the following amounts, to-wit:

City of Prairie du Chien 2023 Expenditures	\$6,303,743.37
City of Prairie du Chien 2023 Revenue	\$2,945,175.64
City of Prairie du Chien General Property Tax	<u>\$3,358,567.73</u>
Apportionment from Crawford County	\$2,651,462.58
Apportionment from SWTC	\$464,610.28
Apportionment from PdC Area School District	\$4,840,499.78
TIF Districts	<u>\$24,197.43</u>
Total Tax Levy	\$11,339,337.80

Section 2. There is hereby levied a tax of \$11,339,337.80 upon all taxable property within the City of Prairie du Chien, Wisconsin, as returned by the Assessor in the year 2022 for the purposes and uses set forth in the Budget. The City Administrator is hereby directed to spread the said tax upon the current tax roll of said City.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be effective from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
